

## Code of conduct for the Chamonix Figure Skating Club

The club's code of conduct applies to all members, as well as to their parents or legal representatives. It is designed to create a positive sporting environment and in joining the club, members and their families agree to respect the club's rules and to demonstrate a good sporting attitude. This attitude is based on the ideals of sport for all, fair play, respect for yourself and others, politeness and a strong team and club spirit. As parents you are your child's most important supporters. You are also their most important role models when it comes to demonstrating a good team spirit and upholding the values of good sportsmanship.

## I agree to:

## Respect the rules and regulations of both the Chamonix Figure Skating club (charter) and the Club des Sports de Chamonix.

- 1. Respect all those involved in running and participating in the club's activities: the committee, coaches, volunteers, fellow skaters, other competitors, judges, members of the public using the ice rink and the ice rink employees.
- 2. Demonstrate a positive and friendly attitude and a good team spirit.
- 3. Have a good sporting attitude towards my child. To support them and not to denigrate, admonish or insult them for their sporting performance.
- 4. Be polite and courteous in all my dealings with the club. Not to use threating language, swear at, insult or defame other members of the club or its organisation.
- 5. Not to behave in any way that could damage the good team spirit or reputation of the club.
- 6. Commit to attend my group's training sessions and holiday 'stages' as set out in the timetables.
  - To be correctly dressed and ready for my lesson at the time stated on the timetable.
  - To let my trainer or a member of the committee know beforehand if I will be late or absent from a training session.
- 7. To follow all instructions given by the club management and coaches and not to interrupt or intervene in any training session.
- \* The coach's decisions are final and cannot be contested by the parents or discussed with the coaches during training time. If a parent disagrees with a decision taken, a written letter should be sent to the committee
  - 8. Respect the rules concerning the presence of parents in the stands and to stay away from the players benches and the areas directly next to the ice.
  - 9. Respect the safety and security rules of the club, its coaches and the rink; including:
    - Not to go onto or leave the ice (for skaters) without express permission of the coach.
    - To bring my child to the rink and to be there to collect them at the end of the lesson (parents).
    - Not to enter the changing room reserved for skaters in the Jaune, Passerelle, Rouge and Orange Groups (parents).
  - 10. Obey the rules of my sport.
    - Respect the rules of the Fédération Française des Sports de Glace and of the Lique AURA
    - Respect all the coaches and judges' decisions.
    - Avoid any form of cheating or violence.
  - 11. Not to take any doping substances, stumulants or alcohol and not to supply them to other athletes.
  - 12. To wear the appropriate clothing to practice my sport.
  - 13. Respect the club and rink's properties and belongings as well as the rink itself, the changing rooms and any vehicles provided by the club.
